Biosecurity, containment and sea lice records were found to be adequately maintained and therefore they have not been inspected again.

No mortality levels exceeding the reporting criteria have been recorded since the last inspection.

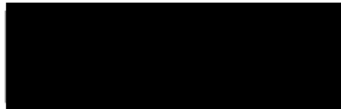
